



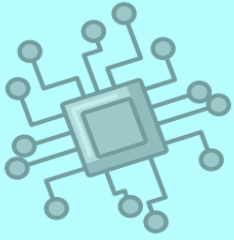

ABOUT THE EVENT-

1. It will be a single round virtual Poster Presentation based on technical themes given.
2. Submissions for the same in the form of a video and PDF file of the Poster in high resolution will be accepted in advance.
3. Every participant must prepare a video of a maximum of 15-minute length which will comprise of:
 - a. Preparation of the poster in fast forward manner &

BASIC RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR PARTICIPATION-

ABOUT THE EVENT-

RULES OF EVENT:

ABOUT THE EVENT:

1. We will release 5 topics on 12th September 2021.
2. Final video must be uploaded by the participants on their google drive and they have to keep it public.
3. The link for the video must be submitted by 14th September 2021, 11 am via Google form.
4. Top 5 participants will be selected by the judges for the on-day screening.
5. The decision of the winner will be made by live voting.

RULES OF EVENT:

1. No cuss/foul words, racist/offensive statements, comments on nationality/religion, or political agenda is to be propagated through your content.
2. Time limit for the video: 5-6 mins
3. Video should be shot in landscape orientation
4. If plagiarized content is observed amongst participants, videos from both the participants to be disqualified on an immediate basis.
5. If plagiarized content is observed on the internet, the participant will be disqualified immediately.
6. Try not to extend much more into the introduction, the prime focus should be the delivery of the content in a limited period.
7. Use of copyrighted content is strictly prohibited. If found, the participant would be dismissed with immediate effect.
8. The video that is being captured needs to be uploaded on your personal Google Drive. The link to it is supposed to be shared in the registration form. The access of the link should be kept to the public. If the access is restricted, the participant will be disqualified. There would be no revelation of your identity throughout the video. No participant should reveal their name, class, division.
9. The students are supposed to register for the event only when you have shot your video. The form contains a mandatory field of providing the link on which the video has been uploaded.
10. Your content should contain a few examples and applications of the topic.
11. Students are free to choose their mode of presentation but every participant should make sure their face is visible and audio is audible in the video.
