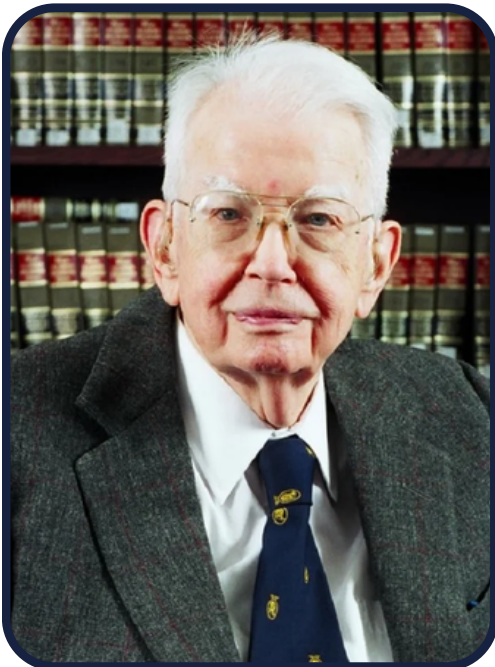

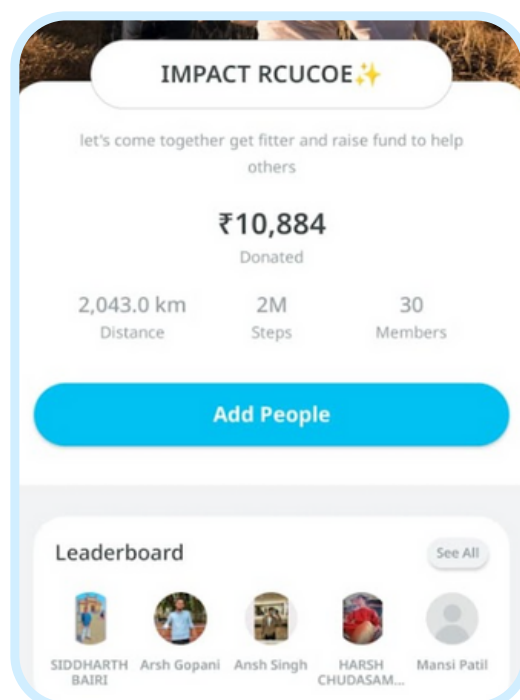
Yaadein Bachpan Ki
