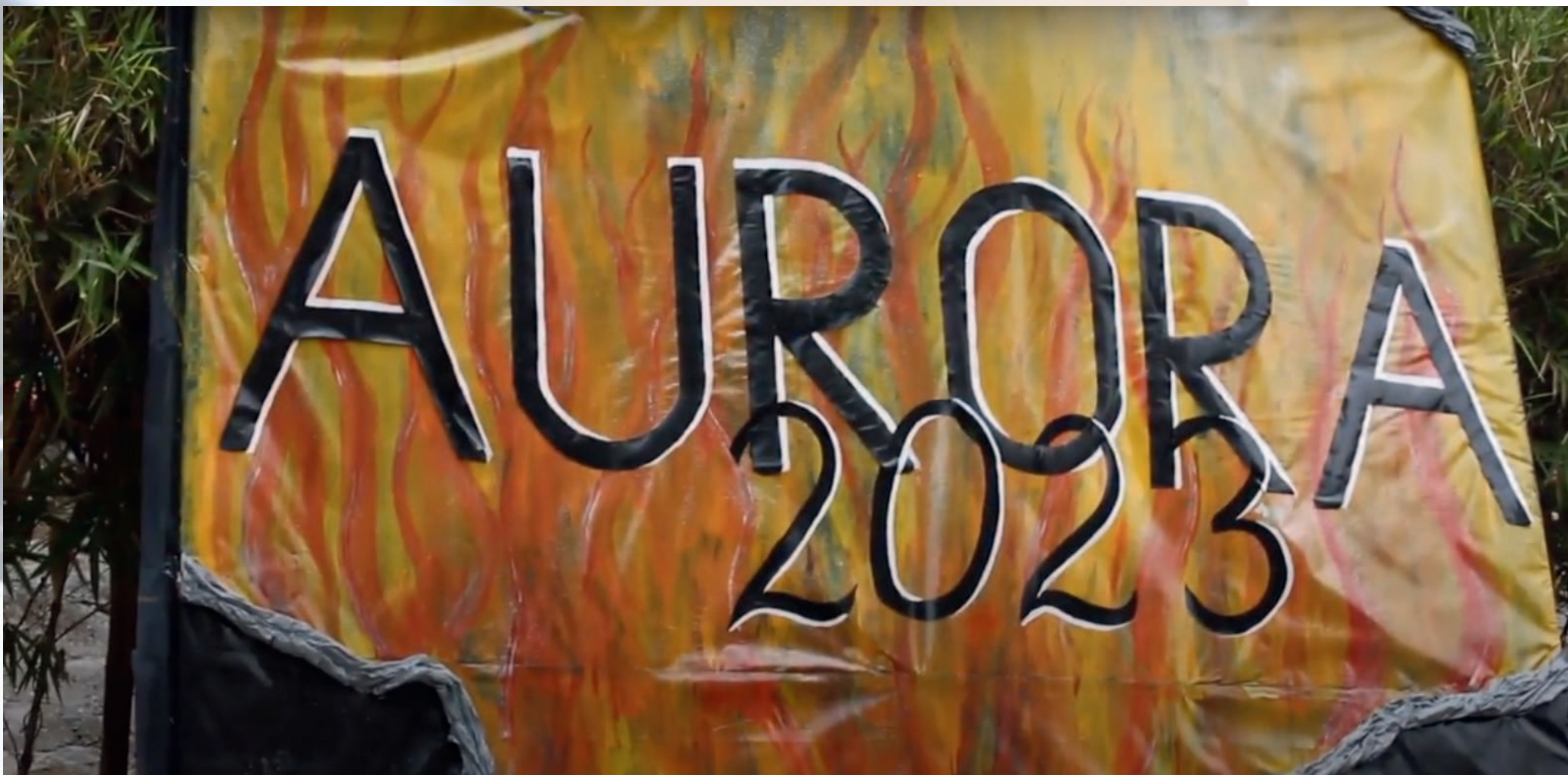
Our Previous Articles
